NOTICE OF OBLIGATION TO CUT WEEDS

To: The residents of property owners of the Township of Ontwa, Cass County, Michigan and any other interested persons.

Please Take Notice that in accordance with Michigan Public Act 184 of 1917, as amended, and Township Ordinance No. 05-06-05, as amended, all weeds in excess of 10 inches in height within all properties of Ontwa Township, must be cut by before the 8th day of June and before the 1st day of July, and again before the 1st day of August 2017. It is the further purpose of this Ordinance to provide for such work to be performed by the Township of Ontwa upon neglect, failure or refusal of the property owner or occupant to do so and for the recovery of costs and expensed incurred by the township as well as to provide penalties for the violations of the Ordinance.

Notice is Hereby given that the township of Ontwa may enter the premises and cut the same as frequently as necessary during 2017 to comply with the foregoing regulations and may charge the cost thereof against the property owner and for collection may place the amount upon the next tax roll of the Township as a tax lien against the offending premises.

Please take further notice that as provided in this ordinance, it is the duty of the Ontwa Township Zoning Administrator to notify the owner, giving him/her (10) days to cause the work to be done, if the said owner fails, it shall be the duty of the Zoning Administrator to cause such vegetation to be cut, destroyed or hauled away. Such cutting obligation shall not apply to fields devoted to growing any small grain food crops such as wheat, corn, oats, barley, rye or garden vegetables.
