RESOLUTION 2018-9-10.5

WHEREAS, the Cass County Drain Commissioner has advised the Ontwa Township Board that certain maintenance and repair is necessary to be performed on the Pleasant Lake Drain; and

WHEREAS, the Cass County Drain Commissioner has authority to expend up to Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$5,000.00) per mile or fraction thereof of drain in any one year for the maintenance and repair of the Drain, and where it is estimated that expenditures in excess of Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$5,000.00) per mile or fraction thereof of drain are necessary, those amounts may not be expended until approved by Resolution of the governing body of each township, city and village affected by more than twenty (20%) percent of the cost when combining the at-large apportionment and the total apportionment for private lands within Ontwa Township pursuant to MCL 280.196(5); and

WHEREAS, the Cass County Drain Commissioner has advised the Ontwa Township Board that it will be necessary to expend funds in excess of Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$5,000.00) per mile or fraction thereof of drain for the maintenance of the Pleasant Lake Drain.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Ontwa Township Board, that pursuant to Section 196 of the Drain Code, the Cass County Drain Commissioner is authorized to expend money for the maintenance and repair of the Pleasant Lake Drain in excess of Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$5,000.00) per mile or fraction thereof and, to the extent that the drain fund for the Pleasant Lake Drain contains insufficient funds for the payment of costs incurred for the maintenance or repair of the Pleasant Lake Drain, then the Cass County Drain Commissioner is authorized to levy a special assessment, as allowed by law.
